It is with great pleasure that the trustees can announce that The EACHSA Trust is now a charity registered with the Charity Commission. This has benefits for us, not least because we can now collect Gift Aid on donations made by UK tax payers!

Our latest delivery arrived in Late June and was distributed by the Outreach Programme supervised by the University of Pretoria. It was delivered at their request to a township 50 kilometres from Johannesburg for further distribution. They were so delighted to receive it that they asked the young lady at Sevenses, the shipping company, to ring me to say thank you, which she did!

Max and Zinette Bergman went out and sent the following e mail

Wonderful! Thank you very much from this side of the hemisphere. Zinette and I have just visited one of the distribution sites for EACHSA books, a home for abandoned or abused children. The books are distributed to homes and schools in the township, supervised by the faculty of education at the University of Pretoria. Zinette will send a report and photos anon. from the photos you will see how valuable the work is. Max

We have now sent 94x 40kg boxes of books, soft toys, pencils and crayons in just over a year thanks to your generosity.

Now we have registered charity status we are getting planning to get new leaflets printed and will be having a Trustees meeting shortly to map out the next year and what we wish to achieve.
